MCGT Website

MCGT Facebook Page and MCGT Twitter Account

The MCGT office and the MCGT state board have the final decision on what to post on the MCGT public Facebook page and the MCGT Twitter account.

MCGT closed members only Facebook group

Anyone who is a member of the MCGT members only closed Facebook group can post events/resources in the group. Our policies, which are posted in the closed Facebook group as a document and are highlighted by a pinned post, are:

No spamming (making the same post over and over) will be allowed on the MCGT Facebook group. Repeated soliciting is also not welcome. We do encourage both professional and non-professional networking on topics related to giftedness, but ask that all members limit their business, blog, or service advertisements to one or two instances, or when other members post seeking related information.
